Day 8 (6 days before Passover)	Evening	
	Morning/Afternoon – travels to reach Bethany “more than a Sabbath’s journey” from Ephraim near the wilderness (John 11:54) which is not supposed to be done on a Sabbath/Saturday. See John 12:1-2.	Friday
Day 9 (5 days before Passover)	Evening – Sundown meal with Mary, Martha, Lazarus (John 12:2-11).	
	Morning/Afternoon – Palm Day (which is “the next day” after arriving in Bethany (John 12:12-13)	Saturday
Day 10 (4 days before Passover)	Evening – Looks around Temple but it is late (Mark 11:9-11)	
	Morning – Inspection/Questioning of Lamb of God begins, Cleansing of Temple, Healing of Blind and Lame	Sunday
Day 11 (3 days before Passover)	Evening	
	Morning – Questions and Teaching in Temple	Monday

Day 12 (2 days before Passover)	Evening	
	Morning – Teaching in Temple continued	Tuesday
Day 13 – The “Day of Preparation of Passover”	Evening – Supper at Simon the Leper’s	
	Morning/Afternoon – Peter and John prepare Passover meal in Upper Room	Wednesday
Day 14 – “Day of Preparation” of Passover/Feast of Unleavened Bread	Evening – Passover/Last Supper after sundown	(Wednesday)
	Morning/Daytime 1 – in tomb before sundown	Thursday
Day 15 – “High Sabbath” Feast Day (John 19:31, Luke 23:54)	Evening 1	
	Morning 2	Friday
Day 17 -	Evening 2 – Regular Sabbath	
	Morning 3 – Regular Sabbath	Saturday
Day 18 -	Evening 3 – Jesus arose at some point before dawn. The tomb was opened to show people it was empty as the sun was rising. (It wasn’t opened to let Jesus out but rather to let people in.)	
	Morning or Daytime – Jesus meets Mary Magdalene, other women plus Simon Peter and John see the empty tomb, Jesus meets with Simon, Cleopas and companion walk to Emmaus.	Sunday
Day 19	Evening – Jesus appears to 10 disciples (not Thomas)
